JANUARY 2012 QUARTERLY UPDATE

These Release Notes accompany the January 2012 quarterly release of the CRSP Survivor-Bias-Free US Mutual Fund Database, and contain data through December 2011.

DATABASE CHANGES

INDEX FUND FLAG HISTORY EXTENDED

History for the index_fund_flag field in fund_hdr is backfilled to 2003 in this release.

DATA CORRECTIONS

Returns with a value of zero preceding the valid date range of the fund with which they were associated were corrected for this release. This correction impacted nearly 130 funds.

FILE VERSION SPECIFICS

The database has 49,343 total funds. Of these 28,428 are active and 20,915 are delisted.

The mutual fund database is available in both SAS and ASCII formats. Due to file sizes, the SAS and ASCII formats of the database are shipped on DVD only.

- A field with a "?" in it is a flag to indicate further research is required.
- A field has a zero in it when 1) The fund did not exist; 2) No value could be found; or 3) A calculated value could not be calculated because information was missing.
